OBJECT: TO SEE HOW MANY STUDENTS CAN GET ON THE PLATFORM AT ONE TIME.

RULES:

REMEMBER THAT ONE OF YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES AS GROUP LEADER IS TO ENCOURAGE SAFETY PROCEDURES.... IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO OCCASIONALLY NIX ANY IDEA IF SOMEONE'S SAFETY IS JEOPARDISED.
